

LIBRARY INFORMATION SHEET

Iona Columba College encourages all its students to enrol online with the State Library of NSW so that they can access a full research library, including a range of data bases to support their learning.

The State Library of New South Wales, part of which is known as the Mitchell Library, is a large heritage-listed special collections, reference and research library open to the public. It is the oldest library in Australia, being the first established in New South Wales in 1826



Library cards are free of charge. Students can sign up for a Library Card [online](#) or when Students are at the Library.

With a Library card Students can:

- use most of the Library's collections
- access e-resources in the Library
- use most of the e-resources including ebooks from anywhere (NSW residents only)
- request books from other libraries
- print and photocopy
- use library computers
- book a study room.

The library's Proquest and EBSCO databases cover business, management, HR, marketing, finances, accounting, health, ageing and community services.

The databases are all online and are quick and easy to use. Students can also consult online with a librarian if they need any help in finding information.



Camden Theological Library

Iona Columba College students have access to Camden Theological Library through the College's arrangement with the Library.

Camden Theological Library is located at 16 Masons Drive, North Parramatta NSW 2151. It is a specialist theological library and a resource of the Uniting Church in Australia, NSW/ACT Synod. The Library provides access to books and other resources in areas such as biblical studies, theology, ministry, pastoral care, counselling, chaplaincy, church history and related disciplines. The collection also includes Korean-language resources, supporting students who undertake study and research in Korean.

Students may use Camden Theological Library to support their study, research and assessment preparation. Students may be able to borrow print books, use reference materials in the Library, search the Revelation catalogue, request assistance from Library staff and access selected learning or research resources.

Students wishing to use the Library should contact Camden Theological Library or ICC Student Administration for guidance before visiting or applying for membership.
